**TO GUARANTEE FRESH CATTLE PLEASE PRE-ENTER THE CATTLE CLASSES
BY AUGUST 19, 2022**

FOR THE ROPING CLASSES: A roping class must have at least **THREE** pre-entered entries at least **15 DAYS** prior to the show for that class to be held. If there are not three entries at the deadline, the class will not be held.

FOR THE SORTING CLASSES: There must be **15 SORTING TEAMS** pre-entered at least **15 DAYS** prior to the show for that class to be held. If there are not 15 teams entered at the deadline, the classes will not be held.

FLAT FEES

\$325 ONE TIME FLAT FEE PER HORSE

FEES, DRUG FEES OR CATTLE FEES.

NOTE: All Western Riding and Trail classes will be held **ONLY** if one class fills with three entries.

DIRECTIONS TO THE FAIRGROUNDS (12525 Robert Larson Blvd):

From the South or North, get on I-10 heading West towards Deming/Las Cruces. After driving onto the mesa West of Las Cruces, get off at the airport exit, Exit 132. Go left (South) across the Interstate and take a right turn on Robert Larson Blvd, directly in front of the Love's Truck Stop. You will be heading West on the frontage road (Robert Larson Blvd.). Go approximately four miles and take a left across the second cattle guard. You will see the Pete Domenici Arena on your right. The show office is located in the small building by the covered arena. If coming from the West, exit I-10 at the Corralitos Exit and proceed to the Fairgrounds.
